




2 - Assembling the cabinet (2 of 2)

- 1) Screw 4 cam screws (A) into the outermost holes in the right (4) and left (5) cabinet sides, and insert 2 dowels (B) into the center set of holes in each.
- 2) Slide the sides into the assembly from step 1, and secure the sides with 8 cam locks (A).






- 1) Screw the handle (C) into the door (9) with the handle screw (D).
- 2) Set the hinges (F) into the cuts in the door and secure with 2 wood screws (E).
- 3) Center the metal door stop (G) on the inside of the right panel of the bowl shroud (6) such that it protrudes into thedoor cut and attach with 2 wood screws (E).
- 4) Attach the right shroud panel to the assembly from step 3 using 2 cam locks (A).



- 1) With the hinges on the door in the closed positions as shown, set the door inside the cutout. Ensure corner of door is flush against the metal door stop and the hinges are flush with the cabinet. Use spacers (a coin, paper, etc, NOT included) to create an even gap at the top and bottom of the door.
- 2) Create a mark on the cabinet front inside the circular holes in the hinges.
- 3) Remove the door and hinges and drill screws halfway into the cabinet at the marked points, then back out.
- 4) Realign the hinges with the screw holes and re-secure the door do the cabinet using the new holes.
- 5) Gently check for proper opening and closing of the door, then secure with the remainder of the wood screws.







- Orient the bracket such that there is space between the top of the bracket and the cabinet, and align the holes in the bracket with the inserts in the face of the cabinet.
- Secure the bowl bracket (H) to the front face of the cabinet using 6 bracket screws (I) as shown.
- 3) Screw the stabilizer nut (K) onto the stabilizer bolt (J), then screw the bolt into the center of the 3 holes in the bottom of the bracket.
